Once you have downloaded the data and have decompressed the file using PKZIP or WinZip, the data can then be imported into a variety of database or spreadsheet packages to facilitate queries or reports.

NOTE: In an effort to improve the quality of our downloadable data, we are now exporting bottom hole locations as calculated from the directional survey associated with the well.

NOTE: The coordinate values were derived using the North American Datum (NAD) 1927.

This system can be used to purchase publicly releasable well log images and well data files. Well Log images are delivered as TIFF images. Well data files are delivered in several format types. Digital LAS well files are not available through this system.

We currently sell custom CDs, custom DVDs and CD/DVD Sets. Custom CDs/DVDs can contain both well logs and Public Information Data Files. Each custom CD costs \$15 and holds a maximum of 680 megabytes of data. Each custom DVD costs \$20 and holds a maximum of 4300 megabytes of data. The CD/DVD Sets are priced according to content.

The Bureau of Ocean Energy Management, Regulation, and Enforcement strives to make available as soon as it is releasable. The Gulf of Mexico Region Notice to Lessees (NTL) clarifies the availability of well data and information. The availability of data through the Online Ordering System will be based on the following:

1. For leases that are still in effect, the availability of well data and information to the Online Ordering System is based on the data and information type according to the NTL 2008-G22.
2. If the lease is no longer in effect, the availability of the well data and information to the Online Ordering System will be determined by the earlier of the following 2 criteria:
 - a. Availability times as determined in the table in NTL 2008-G22.
 - b. 90 days after the date that the lease status is changed in our database, to rights to be exhausted and for processing data. If the lease status is under then availability of well data and information will be withheld pending the res status.

As data and information are processed, additional data will be made available through the System.

The BOEMRE offshore leasing and operations are governed by a wide variety of laws, regulations, and other communications with the offshore industry.

The [Federal Register](#) notices serve to advise the public of upcoming BOEMRE regulatory actions or proposals. [Notices to Lessees](#) are less formal communications with operators and contractors that further clarify regulations. The [Potential Incidents of Noncompliance](#) (PINC) list is the backbone of the the Bureau Inspection Program. It gives our inspectors specific item-by-item checklists of what they should look for when conducting inspections. Similarly, it provides operators and contractors information about exactly what we're watching for during an inspection.
