BE IT KNOWN that before us, the undersigned Notaries Public, duly qualified and commissioned in and for the jurisdictions hereinafter set forth, and before the undersigned competent witnesses, personally came and appeared:

JAMES E. FISHER, JR. (SSN: XXX-XX-0795), an individual of the full age of majority, appearing herein as a son of Jean Nilson Fisher, a sibling of Jeffrey David Fisher, and as a universal legatee of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher, whose mailing address is 314 Indian Bayou #1112, Houston, Texas, 77057, dealing herein with his separate property; and

JOHN MARK FISHER (SSN: XXX-XX-4155), an individual of the full age of majority, appearing herein as a son of Jean Nilson Fisher, a sibling of Jeffrey David Fisher, and as a universal legatee of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher, whose mailing address is 11802 Bunker Hill Circle, Houston, Texas 77024, dealing herein with his separate property; and

MORGAN NILSON FISHER (SSN: XXX-XX-5895), an individual of the full age of majority, appearing herein as a granddaughter of Jean Nilson Fisher, a daughter of Jeffrey David Fisher, and as a universal legatee of the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, which succession is a universal legatee of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher, whose mailing address is 1106 Newning Ave., Austin, Texas 78704, dealing herein with her separate property;

FORREST FISHER (SSN: XXX-XX-3632), an individual of the full age of majority, appearing herein as a grandson of Jean Nilson Fisher, a son of Jeffrey David Fisher, and as a universal legatee of the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, which succession is a universal legatee of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher, whose mailing address is 1106 Newning Ave., Austin, Texas 78704, dealing herein with his separate property; and

EVELYN FISHER (SSN: XXX-XX-0567), an individual of the full age of majority, appearing herein as a granddaughter of Jean Nilson Fisher, a son of Jeffrey David Fisher, and as a universal legatee of the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, which succession is a universal legatee of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher, whose mailing address is 1106 Newning Ave., Austin, Texas 78704, dealing herein with her separate property;

(hereinafter collectively referred to as "Affiants" and individually referred to as "Affiant"),
who, being first duly sworn, did depose and declare that:

1.

Jean Nilson Fisher (a/k/a Jean Earl Fisher) died testate in Harris County, State of Texas, on February 17, 1988. She resided in Harris County, State of Texas, for many years prior to her date of death and was domiciled there at the time of her death. A photocopy of a certified copy of Jean Nilson Fisher's death certificate is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

2.

Jean Nilson Fisher owned immovable property located in the Federal Water Offshore of Louisiana and Outer Continental Shelf of the Gulf of America (formerly known as the Gulf of Mexico), South Marsh Island Block 161 at the time of her death. The assets in the Louisiana Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher consist only of her separate property which is described herein.

3.

Jean Nilson Fisher was married but once and then to James E. Fisher, Sr., which marriage ended in divorce. She was unmarried at the time of her death. Of the marriage to James E. Fisher, Sr., only three (3) children were born, namely, Jeffrey David Fisher, James E. Fisher, Jr., and John Mark Fisher, all of whom survived the deceased. Jeffrey David Fisher survived the deceased but subsequently died on April 6, 2023, testate with surviving descendants. Jean Nilson Fisher had no other children born to or adopted by her.

4.

Jean Nilson Fisher's last will and testament, dated July 12, 1985, and the first codicil to her last will and testament, dated January 4, 1988, have been filed and admitted to probate in the Circuit Court in and for Harris County, State of Texas, by an Order dated March 22, 1988, in Cause No. 693-12-2357, Probate No. 219, 933, Harris County, State of Texas. Exemplified copies of the following documents from the Texas probate proceedings for the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher are attached hereto as Exhibits "B": Application for Probate of Will and for Letters Testamentary, Testimony, Last Will and Testament of Jean Nilson Fisher, First Codicil of Jean Nilson Fisher, Order Admitting Will to Probate and Granting Letters Testamentary, Appointment of Resident Service Agent, Oath of

Independent Co-Executor, Oath of Independent Co-Executor, Notice to Creditors, Inventory, Appraisement and List of Claims.

5.

Article III of Jean Nilson Fisher's last will and testament, dated July 12, 1985, created three (3) testamentary trusts in Texas for her surviving descendants, namely, the Jeffrey David Fisher Testamentary Trust (created for the benefit of Jeffrey David Fisher as the original income and principal beneficiary), the James E. Fisher, Jr., Testamentary Trust (created for the benefit of James E. Fisher, Jr., as the original income and principal beneficiary), and the John Mark Fisher Testamentary Trust (created for the benefit of John Mark Fisher as the original income and principal beneficiary), (referred to herein sometimes collectively as the "testamentary trusts"). James E. Fisher, Sr., signed an Acceptance to be Appointed as the Sole Successor Trustee for the Jeffrey David Fisher Testamentary Trust, James E. Fisher, Jr., signed an Election to be Appointed Successor Trustee for the James E. Fisher, Jr., Testamentary Trust, and John Mark Fisher signed an Election to be Appointed Successor Trustee for the John Mark Fisher Testamentary Trust, exemplified copies of which are all attached hereto as Exhibits "C".

6.

However, all three (3) of the testamentary trusts were previously terminated in their entirety by termination notices filed in Texas by the duly appointed Trustees under the laws of the State of Texas pursuant to V.T.C.A., Property Code 112.059 for Termination of Uneconomic Trusts. Such terminations of trusts were effective immediately upon the filing of the following termination notices in the Probate record for Jean Nilson Fisher in the State of Texas, exemplified copies of which are all attached hereto as Exhibits "D": Notice to Terminate Jeffrey David Fisher Trust, Notice of Trust Termination: James Edwin Fisher, Jr., Trust, and Notice to Terminate John Mark Fisher Trust.

7.

Pursuant to Article III of the last will and testament of Jean Nilson Fisher, the deceased left a universal bequest to the Trustees of the now terminated testamentary trusts created in Article III of the last will and testament of Jean Nilson Fisher, which universal

bequest also includes her interest in the Louisiana immovable property located in the Federal Water Offshore of Louisiana and Outer Continental Shelf of the Gulf of America, South Marsh Island Block 161. As evidenced by paragraphs 5-6 herein, all three (3) of the testamentary trusts were previously terminated by the duly appointed Trustees. As a result of the immediate terminations of the trusts, the testamentary trusts will not be funded herein, and the universal bequests to the Trustees of the testamentary trusts will lapse. Therefore, Affiants desire to instead distribute all of the residue, rest and remainder of the property belonging to the succession of Jean Nilson Fisher in Louisiana to the former original principal beneficiaries of each of the testamentary trusts, namely, the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher (former principal beneficiary of the Jeffrey David Fisher Testamentary Trust) represented by his descendants Morgan Nilson Fisher, Forrest Fisher, and Evelyn Fisher as discussed in paragraphs 9-14 below, James E. Fisher, Jr. (former principal beneficiary of the James E. Fisher Testamentary Trust), and John Mark Fisher (former principal beneficiary of the John Mark Fisher Testamentary Trust):

"ARTICLE III.

Descendants' Trusts

3.1 If any descendant of mine survives me, I give all of the residue of my estate to my Trustee, IN TRUST, to be administered as provided in this Article. My Trustee shall divide the trust property (and property allocated pursuant to other provisions of this Will) into equal shares as follows: One share for each of my sons who survives me and one share for each of my sons who fails to survive me but who has one or more descendants who survive me. Each share set aside for the descendants of one of my sons who fails to survive me shall be further divided into portions for such descendants per stirpes. Each share hereby set aside for one of my sons who survives me and each share or portion hereby set aside for a descendant of one of my sons who fails to survive me shall constitute a separate trust, and the records of my Trustee shall be kept accordingly. Each such trust shall be known by the name of my son or other descendant shall be the primary beneficiary of such trust during such Beneficiary's lifetime."

8.

Therefore, the universal bequest to the Trustees of the testamentary trusts will lapse, and all of the residue, rest and remainder of the Louisiana property belonging to the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher will pass to the respective principal beneficiaries of each of the testamentary trusts, as the universal legatees of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher,

namely, Jeffrey David Fisher, James E. Fisher, Jr., and John Mark Fisher, in equal and undivided one-third (1/3) shares to each, outright and unencumbered by trust.

9.

James E. Fisher, Jr., John Mark Fisher, and Jeffrey David Fisher all survived the deceased; however, Jeffrey David Fisher subsequently died on April 6, 2023, testate with surviving descendants. Therefore, James E. Fisher, Jr., John Mark Fisher, and the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher are entitled to be recognized as the universal legatees of the Jean Nilson Fisher, and, as such, are entitled to be recognized as the owners of and placed in possession of an undivided one-third (1/3) share to each, outright and unencumbered by trust. Jeffrey David Fisher's one-third (1/3) share of Jean Nilson Fisher's property will now pass through his succession under the terms of his last will and testament and succeed to his surviving legatees, which legatees appear herein as affiants to accept their interests, and whose addresses appear above.

10.

Jeffrey David Fisher died testate on April 6, 2023, while present in Harris County, State of Texas. Although Jeffrey David Fisher died while present in Harris County, State of Texas, he resided in Travis County, State of Texas for many years prior to his date of death and was domiciled there at the time of his death. A photocopy of a certified copy of the death certificate of Jeffrey David Fisher is attached hereto as Exhibit "E".

11.

Jeffrey David Fisher executed a last will and testament valid under the laws of the State of Texas, and which last will and testament has been filed and admitted to probate in the Circuit Court in and for Travis County, Texas by an Order signed and dated June 13, 2023, in Cause No. C-1-PB-23-001039, Travis, County, Texas. Exemplified copies of the following documents from the Texas probate proceeding are attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibits "F": Application for Probate of Will and For Letters Testamentary, Last Will and Testament of Jeffrey David Fisher and Self Proving Affidavit, Designation of Resident Agent, Order Admitting Will to Probate and Authorizing Letters Testamentary, Proof of Death and Other Facts, Oath of Independent Executor, Statement and Proof of

Claim, Independent Executor's Affidavit of Notice Pursuit to Texas Estates Code Chapter 308, First Application for Extension of Time to File Inventory, Affidavit in lieu of Inventory, Appraisement and list of Claims.

12.

Jeffrey David Fisher's only interest in immovable property in the State of Louisiana at the time of his death was in the portion of the Louisiana property inherited from the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher described in paragraphs 9 and 10 above, and which property is located in the Federal Water Offshore of Louisiana and Outer Continental Shelf of the Gulf of America, South Marsh Island Block 161. The assets in the Louisiana Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher consisted only of separate property which is described herein.

13.

Jeffrey David Fisher was married only once and then to Susan Delaine Fisher, which marriage ended in divorce. Jeffrey David Fisher was unmarried at the time of his death. Of the marriage to Susan Delaine Fisher, only three (3) children were born, namely, Evelyn Fisher, Morgan Nilson Fisher, and Forrest Fisher, all of whom survived the deceased. Jeffrey David Fisher had no other children born to or adopted by him.

14.

Pursuant to Article III of the last will and testament of Jeffrey David Fisher, he left the following bequest, which bequest also includes his interest in the Louisiana immovable property inherited from the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher herein, and which property is located in the Federal Water Offshore of Louisiana and Outer Continental Shelf of the Gulf of America, South Marsh Island Block 161:

"III.

DISPOSITION OF ESTATE

- A. If my wife, Susan Delaine Fisher, survives me, I give devise and bequeath all of my estate of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated to my wife, Susan /delaine Fisher. If my wife, Susan Delaine Fisher, does not survive me, I give, devise and bequeath all of my estate to my children, Morgan N. Fisher and Forrest Fisher, in equal shares; provided, however, that if a child of mind shall not then survive me, but should leave issue then surviving me, such then surviving issue shall take, per stirpes, the share that such deceased child would have taken by surviving me, or if*

none is then living, then said share shall be distributed to my then living child or his or her issue, per stirpes, or if none of my descendants is then living, then said share shall be distributed as provided in the paragraph below."

15.

The marriage of Jeffrey David Fisher to Susan Delaine Fisher ended in divorce after the execution of his last will and testament; therefore, the legacy to Susan Delaine Fisher will lapse. None of Jeffrey David Fisher's children were forced heirs as of his date of death pursuant to Louisiana Civil Code article 1493. Evelyn Fisher, Morgan Nilson Fisher, and Forrest Fisher all survived Jeffrey David Fisher; therefore, Evelyn Fisher, Morgan Nilson Fisher, and Forrest Fisher, are entitled to be recognized as the universal legatees of the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, and, as such, are the owners of and should be placed in possession of all of all of the Louisiana property belonging to the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, in equal and undivided one-third (1/3) shares to each, which property also includes, but is not limited to, all of Jeffrey David Fisher's undivided one-third (1/3) interest in and to the immovable property inherited herein from the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher (A/K/A Jean Earl Fisher).

16.

Therefore, James E. Fisher, Jr., John Mark Fisher, and the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, represented herein by the universal legatees of the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher, namely, Evelyn Fisher, Forrest Fisher, and Morgan Nilson Fisher, all of whom are affiants appearing herein, are each entitled to be recognized as the universal legatees of the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher (A/K/A Jean Earl Fisher), and, as such, are the owners of and should be placed in possession of all of the Louisiana property belonging to the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher, which property includes, but is not limited to, Jean Nilson Fisher's interest in the property located in the Federal Water Offshore of Louisiana and Outer Continental Shelf of the Gulf of America (formerly known as the Gulf of Mexico), South Marsh Island Block 161, which property is more particularly described below in paragraph 17, in the following portions to each: an undivided one-third (1/3) share passes to James E. Fisher, Jr., an undivided one-third (1/3) share passes to John Mark Fisher, and an undivided one-third (1/3) share passes through the Succession of

Jeffrey David Fisher to his universal legatees, namely, Evelyn Fisher, Morgan Nilson Fisher and Forrest Fisher (in equal and undivided one-third (1/3) shares to each) resulting in an undivided one-ninth (1/9) share passing to Evelyn Fisher, an undivided one-ninth (1/9) share passing to Morgan Nilson Fisher, and an undivided one-ninth (1/9) share passing to Forrest Fisher.

17.

Jean Nilson Fisher's (A/K/A Jean Earl Fisher) Louisiana separate property includes, but is not limited to, the following property:

The gross value of the succession of Jean Nilson Fisher is under \$125,000.00.

21.

Further, affiants, Evelyn Fisher, Morgan Nilson Fisher, and Forrest Fisher, are entitled to be recognized as the universal legatees of the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher and, as such, are the owners of and should be placed in possession of all of the property belonging to the Succession of Jeffrey David Fisher in equal and undivided one-third (1/3) shares to each, which property is particularly described in paragraph 22 below, and which property is comprised of the same one-third (1/3) total share of the immovable property located in the Federal Water Offshore of Louisiana and Outer Continental Shelf of the Gulf of America, South Marsh Island Block 161 which was inherited from the Succession of Jean Nilson Fisher (A/K/A Jean Earl Fisher) and described in paragraphs 14-17 above.

As such, Affiants, **JAMES E. FISHER, JR.**, whose current mailing address is 314 Indian Bayou #1112, Houston, Texas, 77057, **JOHN MARK FISHER**, whose current mailing

of a trust created by Article III ceases to act, the power to appoint a successor shall be exercisable by the Beneficiary of such trust (or by the parents or guardian of a minor Beneficiary or by the guardian of an incompetent Beneficiary) for a period of 60 days. If the corporate Trustee of any other trust ceases to act, the power to appoint a successor shall be exercisable by the Ward of such trust for a period of 60 days. If no successor Trustee has been appointed within such 60 day period, then upon written request of any interested party, the then presiding judge of the court in which my Will was originally admitted to probate, acting as an individual and not in any judicial capacity, shall have the power to appoint a successor. Except as provided in other sections, any successor Trustee shall be a bank with trust powers or a trust company, state or national, with a combined capital and surplus of at least \$10,000,000.

5.5 Every fiduciary shall be reimbursed for the reasonable costs and expenses incurred in connection with such fiduciary's duties. Every corporate fiduciary shall be entitled to fair and reasonable compensation for services rendered by such fiduciary in an amount not exceeding the customary and prevailing charges for services of a similar character at the time and at the place such services are performed. No individual fiduciary shall receive compensation for serving under this Will.

5.6 If, in the opinion of a corporate Trustee named and eligible to serve or already serving, it is or becomes uneconomical for it to serve or continue to serve because of the size of such trust, then if a Co-Trustee is serving, it may resign or refuse to serve, or if no Co-Trustee is serving, it may resign or refuse to serve and appoint an individual as alternate or successor Trustee. Furthermore, if such corporate Trustee is serving and at the time such trust has a net asset value (on the books of such corporate fiduciary) less than the amount that would have had the same purchasing power as \$50,000 had on January 1, 1985 (based on the U.S. Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers applicable to Houston, Texas), such corporate Trustee may terminate such trust by complete distribution to the Beneficiary or the Ward of such trust.
