Dear Ms. Salinas:

Your letter dated July 25, 2025, requesting cancellation of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Mineral Lessee's or Operator's Supplemental Bond No. N-8100124, in the amount of \$327,338, was received by our office on July 28, 2025. This bond, conditioned to cover Right-of-Way OCS-G 29598, was executed on April 20, 2022, with Talos Energy Offshore LLC as principal and Indemnity National Insurance Company as surety.

The Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement has assessed the decommissioning liability for OCS-G 29598 to be \$0. Therefore, the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management has no objection to cancellation of Bond No. N-8100124, which is considered cancelled without residual liability effective July 30, 2025, the date of final concurrence with the cancellation.
