Dear Ms. Koletar:

Your letter dated February 5, 2026, requesting cancellation of Outer Continental Shelf (OCS) Mineral Lessee's or Operator's Supplemental Bond No. SBP150014_034, in the amount of \$2,145,000, was received by our office on that same date. This bond, conditioned to cover Lease OCS-G 27051, all of Block 339, East Cameron Area, South Addition, was executed on November 21, 2022, with Talos ERT LLC as principal and Pennsylvania Insurance Company as surety.

Attached to and forming a part of Bond No. SBP150014_034, is Decrease Bond Rider, executed on October 16, 2025, which decreases the bond amount by \$716,888 for a total penal sum of \$1,428,112. The rider is effective October 16, 2025.

Attached to and forming a part of Bond No. SBP150014_034, is Decrease Bond Rider, executed on December 3, 2025, which decreases the bond amount by \$1,198,304 for a total penal sum of \$229,808. The rider is effective December 3, 2025.

The Bureau of Safety and Environmental Enforcement has assessed the decommissioning for G27051 to be \$0. Therefore, the Bureau of Ocean Energy Management has no objection to cancellation of Bond No. SBP150014_034, which is considered cancelled without residual liability effective February 9, 2026, the date of final concurrence with the cancellation.


