By letter dated February 6, 2025, with additional information submitted through March 31, 2025, Renaissance Offshore, LLC (Renaissance) requests a Suspension of Production (SOP) for Lease OCS-G 36201 (the Lease), Vermilion (VR) Block 385. The Lease was held by prior production through February 11, 2025.

On February 11, 2024, VR 385 Well A015 (the Well), the only producing well on the Lease, was shut-in due to sand production. Renaissance conducted wireline operations in attempt to clear sand from the tubing of the Well, but was unsuccessful. Renaissance will conduct coiled tubing operations to clear the sand and install new gravel pack screens. Upon completion of the coiled tubing operations, Renaissance will restore production from the Lease by August 2025.

An SOP for Lease OCS-G 36201 is hereby approved, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.174(a), from February 12 through August 31, 2025. Renaissance, or any subsequent operator, is expected to follow the enclosed activity schedule and must notify this office in writing (progress report) by the end of each month that a deadline is scheduled.
