Dear Mr. Parkman:

By letter dated March 27, 2025, with additional information provided through June 23, 2025, EC Offshore Properties, Inc. (ECOP) requests a Suspension of Production (SOP) for Lease OCS-G 13576 (the Lease), East Cameron Block 71. The Lease was held by a prior SOP through March 31, 2025.

ECOP has repaired onshore facilities, acquired the necessary production equipment, and executed transportation and separation agreements. Upon completion of the testing of an offshore pipeline segment and onshore pipeline repairs related to its onshore facilities, ECOP expects to restore production from the Lease by the end of July 2025.

An SOP for Lease OCS-G 13576 is hereby approved, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.174(a), from April 1 through August 31, 2025. ECOP, or any subsequent operator, must notify this office in writing upon commencement of production.
