Dear Ms. Deady:

By letter dated May 29, 2025, amended June 11, 2025, and additional information provided through August 1, 2025, Arena Offshore, LP (Arena) requests a Suspension of Production (SOP) for Lease OCS-G 1106 (the Lease), West Delta (WD) Block 133. The Lease was held by a prior SOP through June 30, 2025.

Production from the Lease was shut in on January 3, 2024, due to a disruption of flow in Pipeline Segment Number 15823. An initial pigging operation to clear the disruption was unsuccessful, and Arena, Renaissance Offshore, LLC, and Crescent Midstream worked to mobilize equipment to get the pipeline back in service. Additional time was needed to obtain an appropriate coil tubing unit and mobilize it to the host platform at WD Block 152. After successful remediation of the pipeline obstruction, Arena will restore production from the Lease by October 2025.

An SOP for Lease OCS-G 1106 is hereby approved, pursuant to 30 CFR 250.174(a), from June 1 through October 31, 2025. Arena, or any subsequent operator, must notify this office in writing upon commencement of production.
