Dear Mr. Wilkins:

On June 29, 2010, ATP Oil & Gas Corporation (ATP) submitted a request to downhole commingle production from the Upper Yellow C and Lower Yellow D Sand Reservoirs in Well A-1 ST00BP00, API No. 608174115100, Lease OCS-G 16661, Mississippi Canyon Block 941. This request is approved in accordance with 30 CFR 250.1158 and Notice to Lessees and Operators (NTL) No. 99-G19.

ATP plans to perforate the Upper Yellow C Sand Reservoir from 16,330' to 16,440' MD and the Lower Yellow D Sand Reservoir from 16,650' to 16,720' MD and downhole commingle the production. The reservoirs have similar pressures, fluid properties, and drive mechanisms. Increased recovery is anticipated from this procedure.

This completion is also subject to the approval requirements of our New Orleans District Office. If this well is produced as proposed, ATP shall submit well test data on Form MMS-126, Well Potential Test (WPT) Report. If the commingled reservoir is determined to be sensitive, reservoir data shall be submitted on Form MMS-127, Sensitive Reservoir Information (SRI) Report. In addition, approval from the Reservoir Analysis Unit is required before producing any completion in the gas cap of a sensitive reservoir. These requirements are in accordance with 30 CFR 250.1154, 30 CFR 250.1155, and 30 CFR 250.1157.

All present and future completions in any of these combined reservoirs shall be included under the commingled reservoir nomenclature, Yellow Up C/Low D. However, approval must be obtained before physically commingling production from these reservoirs in any other well.
